Pre-Emergent

Applying a pre-emergent treatment is a simple way to keep your lawn lush and weed free this spring and summer. We recommend having your lawn treated with a pre-emergent herbicide in early March through April to keep crab grass and other unsightly weeds from stealing your yard's beauty. Pre-emergent will also keep your planting beds weed free.

Pruning



Pruning trees and shrubs is important to promote plant health, encourage flower and fruit development, or achieve the desired tree form or plant size. Crane Fly

You'll start to see evidence of the Crane Fly in the spring when your turf begins to grow and brown or dead patches appear. February is the ideal time to have your turf sampled and treated.

The larvae look like tubular worms and the adult resembles a giant mosquito. They will feed into spring, typically hatching in July and August. Larvae or Leatherjackets feed on grass roots and foliage. Give us a call if you would like to have your lawn tested and treated.
